Let me begin by thanking you for being part of our Church family. This December will mark my 17th year as your Parish Priest, and more importantly three years of us worshipping in our new church. Every day, when I stand before my icons in prayer, I thank God for the opportunity to serve and minister to you. One of the greatest joys in my life is having the opportunity to serve you. As you know, we are living in some very exciting times here at St. John the Divine. This month, we will usher in the first phase of our new iconography project. Over the last three years, we have grown into our new space with additional ministries, aiming to meet every demographic of our community. We have added new ministries such as the Boy Scouts, Zoe Ministry (For Widows), and Starting Fresh (a ministry for those separated and divorced) just to name a few. In addition, many of you see new faces each week, with record number of people entering our Catechism and Bible Study courses from all over the country. Our viewership for our services has increased, and so has our social media presence. We've had to increase both our staff and our clergy, to meet the growing demands of this community, which exist both in person and online. We have grown while remaining true to our roots and never forgetting 107-year history. There is no doubt that we are working towards the final commandment of God to, "go out to all nations..."

With that said, we must remember that to whom much is given, much is expected. Christ tells us that, "the harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few." St. John Chrysostom goes on to say, "the most successful Churches are not limited by the 4 walls of the Church, but they make their Church the 4 corners of the world." Dear Church Family,


Thanks be to God, St. John the Divine is growing. We are growing in worship, in attendance, in ministries and in our impact to the greater Jacksonville community. Your stewardship provides the foundation for parish ministries and sustains church operations, which helps our church family live their faith and grow in Christ.

As we continue to grow, it is important to understand our church's financial well-being and overall state of operations.

Since fully reopening from Covid, our **Operating Expenses (Red Bar)** have risen **123%** whereas **Stewardship (Blue Bar)** has risen only **63%**.

We have all experienced the pain of hyper inflation over the past few years and the church is not immune from rising costs.

Thanks be to God our fundraising activity and Early Learning Center have helped us stay afloat but as you can see, in 2022 and 2023, we've had to dip into Reserves to fund operations.



Our 2024 operating budget is **\$1,409,404** or **\$3,861 Per Day**, and that is just to break even. But let's be clear, remaining status quo is NOT our goal. Our goal is to continuously grow in Christ and do God's work. There are so many areas of need and they all require resources.

We ask that you prayerfully consider your stewardship for 2024 and join us in committing to the future of St. John the Divine. With God, together we thrive!


The Greek Dance Ministry threw an amazing Night Under the Stars event that raised funds for the Youth Dance Group.

Fr. Nick and Fr. Sebastian are able to touch the lives of so many of our Church family members through our ministries, which are funded by your stewardship.














School Supplies are a necessity and many of the area families cannot purchase them. Only through your generosity can these children be helped.

Total Revenue vs. Expenses




