

GOYA Code of Conduct

As a member of the St. John the Divine GOYA Organization

- I. I acknowledge that I am representing St. John the Divine Greek Orthodox Church at all times.
- II. I will not indulge in any unhealthy actions and/or behavior at a Church event.
- III. I will not use any harsh language towards anyone at a Church event.
- IV. I will not use violence and intimidation towards others.
- V. I will put safety first and will not act in a reckless manner.
- VI. I will respect the clergy at St. John the Divine and every other church GOYA visits.
- VII. I will not mention or bring weapons, drugs, inappropriate items/games, alcohol, tobacco/nicotine (including e-cigarettes) to any event.
- VIII. I will not wear any inappropriate or vulgar clothing. I will not wear anything advertising alcohol, tobacco/nicotine, or anything violent or anti-Christian.
- IX. I will treat fellow GOYAnS with respect and kindness.
- X. I will not vandalize any property whether owned by the church or the establishment that GOYA uses for an event. I will be held responsible and liable for any damage to property, public or personal.

Infractions and Consequences

Any GOYAn that displays a breach of conduct will have a responding consequence. There will be consequences chosen by the head Priest and may include:

Verbal Warning
Removal from activity
Suspension from activities

If an advisor has to reprimand a GOYAn three times in an event, then the advisor and other supervising adults reserve the right to call the GOYAn's parents and send them home. Repeated infractions may impact a GOYAn's ability to attend future GOYA events.

Refusal to follow the Code of Conduct after all three of these consequences will result in more severe consequences.
